The Meaning and Importance of Baptism

Baptism doesn't make you a Christian – it shows that you already are a Christian. Baptism does not "save" you – only your faith in Christ does that. Baptism is like a wedding ring – it is the outward symbol of the commitment you make in your heart.

I. Why Should I Be Baptized?

- 1. To follow the example set by Jesus. Matt 3:13-17; Mark 1:9-11; Luke 3:21, 22
- 2. Because Christ instructed it. Matt. 28:19-20
- 3. It was faithfully practiced in the early church as a means of public declaration of faith in Christ. Acts 2:41; 8:12, 35-39; 9:18; 10:48; 16:31-34; 18:8; 19:5

II. What Is The Meaning of Baptism

- 1. It is an illustration of the central message of the Gospel, that Christ died, was buried, and rose again in order that we might have life. *Rom.* 10:9-10; I Cor. 15:3-4; I Pet 1:3-5, 18-21
- 2. As a picture of burial and resurrection, it portrays what has happened in my life spiritually. *Rom. 6:1-11; II Cor. 5:17; Col. 2:9-12*

III. Why Be Baptized By Immersion?

- 1. Every baptism in the New testament is characterized by this word "baptize", which means "to immerse or dip under water".
- 2. It best symbolizes a burial and resurrection.

IV. Who Should Be Baptized?

Every person who has believed in Christ. Matt 28:19-20; Acts 2:38-41; Rom. 6:1-11
